Building

Trust has developed world class infrastructure for the pharmacy college so that all the students can feel free to take active part in day to day academic activities at the college. The total constructed area of the multi storied building is about 4571.44 SqM. The building consists of four class room theaters each with 72 seating capacity, one tutorial hall, one information centre, twelve laboratories, well spacious library, separate boys and girls common rooms, faculty chambers, principal's chamber with strong room, board room, internet system, RO plant for drinking water and pollution free environment.

Payment of Fee:

The fees as prescribed by Shikshan Shulka Samiti for the college shall be paid by the student in the form of demand draft / pay order of any Nationalized / Scheduled bank. Demand draft / pay order should be drawn in favour of "Gahlot Institute of Pharmacy" payable at Navi Mumbai / Mumbai.

Cheques and cash will not be accepted.

University Fees:

The candidate shall be required to pay the university fee as prescribed by competent authority from time to time. This include University share of fees, examination fees, enrolment fee, sports and cultural fees, etc.

RULES GOVERNING STUDENT:

Attendance:

Attendance at all lectures / tutorials/tests/examination/seminars is compulsory.

A student who is not regular in attendance or fails to carry out his work to the satisfaction of the Principal liable for cancellation of his/her term.

The students who don't have the minimum required attendance of 80% of actual lecture periods conducted, or who do not show satisfactory progress will not be allowed to appear for final examinations.

Periodic tests/seminars conducted in each semester are compulsory.

In case a student remains absent for the periodic tests no re-examination will be conducted and no improvement test will be conducted.

Leave and absence:

Student remaining absent is required to submit a leave application immediately duly countersigned by the parent/guardian.

The parent / guardian of the students are kept informed about the attendance and performance of the student. The co-operation of the parent/guardian in correcting the drawbacks of his/her ward is imperative.

Discipline:

Every student is responsible to the college and should take utmost care of the college premises and property.

Any damage done to the property of the college is to be compensated either indivividually or collectively.

Any damage to the college building furniture and fixtures by the students shall be treated as breach of discipline.

Students should be regular and punctual. Appropriate action will be taken against late comers.

Student will not be allowed to skip any lecture of the day. They are not supposed to loiter in the college corridors or play or play in the gymkhana when the Lectures/Practical's are in progress.

Smoking and use of tobacco in any form are strictly prohibited in the college premises.

Cell phone should be switched off in the college campus.

No student shall collect any money without the written permission of the Principal.

No student is allowed to indulge in any political activity or in any activities detrimental to the interest of the college.

No progress, meeting, gathering or picnic will be conducted without the written approval of the principal. No notice shall be put up on the notice board, without the written permission of the principal.

Ragging is a punishable offence. Any such act will be treated as breach of discipline and the student will be expelled from the college.

Identity Card:

Every bonafide student shall obtain identity card carrying his/her latest photograph and bearing the signature of the principal, which should be collected immediately after admission. This card should be swiped immediately after entering the college. In case the card is not swiped, the student will be considered absent on record. This card must be produced whenever demanded by teaching and non-teaching staff. In case of loss of identity card, it should be reported to the college office immediately. A duplicate identity card can be obtained by paying an amount of Rs.25/-.

Railway and Bus Concession:

Student's age below 25 years can avail of this concession from the college office by filling the railway concession form. Bus concession can also be duly availed.

Schedule of the Course:

In order to obtain the B.Pharm Degree candidate is required to pass eight semesters. All the examinations will be conducted by University of Mumbai. There is periodic test in each semester for theory as well as for practical.

To ensure uniform attention of the students to their work throughout the course of their study, the marks at each of the above mentioned examinations are awarded jointly on the basis of the semester examination (80%) and periodic tests (20%).

To pass each semester, the candidate must obtain at least:

40 % of marks in each theory head

40% of marks in each practical head and

40% of total marks assigned to whole examination.

Degree will be awarded to the candidates who have passed all eight semesters.
