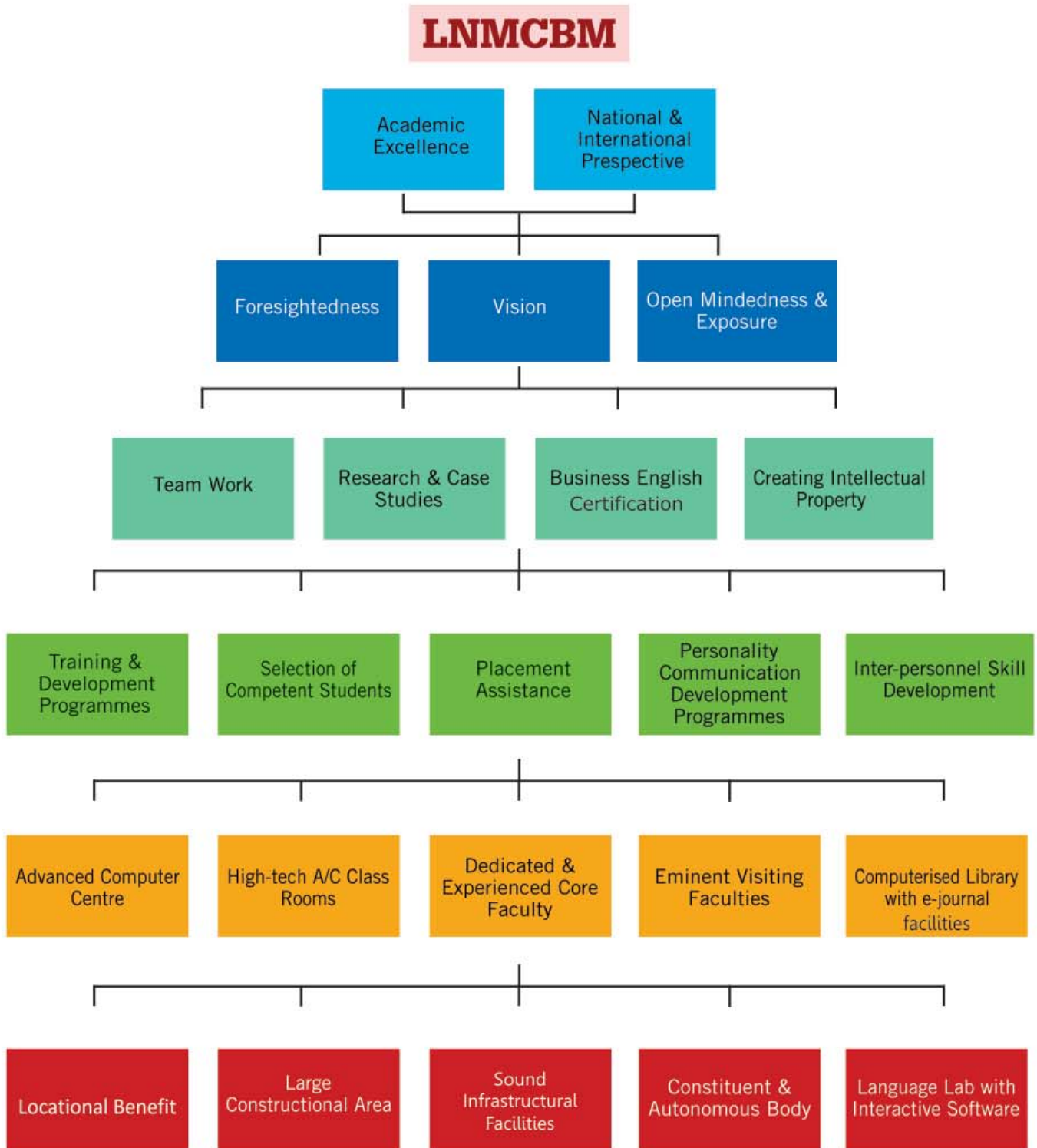
Campus

Classroom

Our class rooms are equipped with constant, ubiquitous connectivity and are updated with technology so that learners may be able to adjust as early as possible with the changes happening now a days. The College has well designed and equipped air conditioned classrooms having adequate space. Bespoke audio/visual aids, LCD projectors, interactive board, laptop, portable sound system make the learning experience a world class one. Class tests on weekly or fortnightly pattern, quizzes, presentation etc. are some regular features of our classrooms. Both theoretical and practical centric classroom teachings are encouraged to ensure better learning experience.



IT Centre

The use of technology in the classroom can enhance learning. There's a whole world of tools online that allow teachers to provide more skill-building knowledge than ever before. Keeping this in view the College Management pays keen interest on practical exposure to students with Information Technology.

The College houses three extra large state of the art computer labs equipped with modern technical aids, having more than 300 computers, interconnected over LAN through Lenovo server. The computers are connected to WIFI connectivity. All three labs are sufficient to provide one to one sitting/usage facility. The

students are given 'free hours on computer for open exercise of their knowledge.' There is additional Computer Organisation Lab for practical exposure on hardware, its organisation and architecture.



Language Lab

To address the basic shortfall of language teaching / learning a standard and premium edition of digital language lab with extensive study material has been set up in the college. It encourages cooperative and collective learning through its interactive and live sessions. Practice sessions with instant scoring facility enable the learners to assess and review their individual development. The target is to facilitate proficiency in four basic skills of language learning i.e. Listening, Speaking, Reading and Writing (LSRW) which ensures the ability to communicate effectively at workplace.



Reading Room

The College has a reading room where students can browse through relevant reference books, journals, national and international weekly, fortnightly, monthly and annual magazines, leading national dailies, newsletters and project-reports. It remains open for 12 hours from 7am to 7pm and supervised by a team of active and efficient support staff.



Library

The College library is a power house of information for faculty members, students, reserchers and Academicians. Accessibility to knowledge resources from diverse sources, countries and authors facilitate better learning environment. Keeping this in view the library of the College under the guidance of a professor-in-charge has been made well furnished and attempts are taken rigorously to achieve excellence. The library subscribes to 52 Indian and 21 foreign journals and has got 65,000 volumes. The library also have e-books and e-journals of national and International repute. A large number of volumes of current publications are added every year. It also boasts of housing back volumes of elite publications including Harvard Business Review etc. The library has more than 200 CDs and VCDs, annual reports, newsletters, research publications, Ph.D. thesis, and project reports for the benefit of the researchers. The 'open access system' facilitates free accessibility to books on-the-shelf in contrast to off-the-shelf accessibility. The library has been modernised by installing Computerised Library Information System for faster access to information.



Cafeteria

The cafeteria comes live with ideas and innovation as students throng the space after classes and spend time conversing with peers, seniors and juniors. This is also the place that builds inter-curriculum conversations. This brings freshness to the beleaguered brains and prepares them for the next set of classes. Hot snacks and soft drinks served in the café offer delightful company to the students.

Bankers

The College is armed with "in-house" service of UCO Bank, a nationalised bank, to ease money matters of the students. State Bank of India located 250 meters away from the college also serves the needs of students. Alliance with the Axis Bank, Maripur branch is another advantage. These banks provide educational loans and other banking benefits to our students.

Security

The Campus of the College is protected from unauthorized persons/invaders by Security Guards to provide fearless vibrant campus to students, particularly Girls, by hiring a security service company. For close monitoring of students' activities, entire campus including class rooms is equipped with CCTV camera.

Other Scholarships and Credit Card

Our college is registered on National Scholarship Portal (NSP 2.0) which enlists multiple scholarships offered by the central Government, State Government, and other government institutions like AICTE, UGC, etc. for students to enable them to complete their education. Students of this college who are socially and economically weak (SC/ST/OBC/Minority) get scholarship from time to time through this Portal. Students of our college also get benefitted from Bihar Student Credit Card Scheme that provides funding to students who require financial assistance for their education.

Common Room

The College provides co-educational learning programme. A modern common room armed with modern amenities has been created for students to spend leisure/off classes timings.

Medical Facilities

To meet any eventuality, the College provides first aid medical support to students, faculty and staff. The College has tie-up with medical practitioners/consultants to provide medical care to students as and when required.

Students Safety Package Insurance

All the admitted students in the College are covered under "Students Safety Package Insurance" from The New India Assurance Co. Ltd. Premium amount is paid by the College which covers the accidental insurance during their studentship at this College alongwith the facility of payment of the remaining course fee of the students in case of accidental death of their parents.

Student's Committee

To make the students creative, innovative to develop and expedite their managerial skills, the college constitutes a number of committees of students which operate under the guidance of experienced faculty members. This helps integrate the students to the college system. The college look after different activities held at regular intervals.



Administrative Support

The College has a team of administrative support offices headed by Director, Additional Director (Administration) and supported by Administrative Officer-cum-Registrar. The team works on a modular basis, each module/team being governed by an officer supported by working staff. Staff members are always ready for providing active support to students' affairs and for addressing their issues and seeking solutions. The structure works for the welfare of students and faculty thriving College activities.

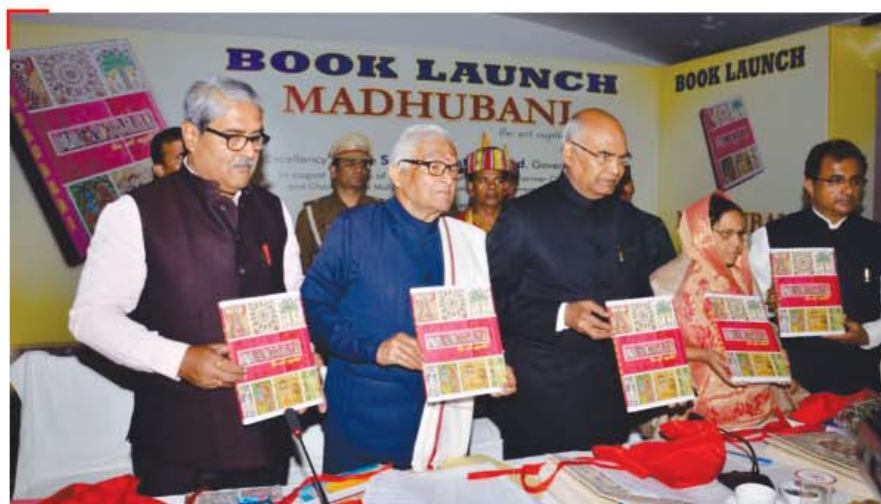
Promoting Art and Culture of Bihar

An attempt has been made to explore the heritage of Bihar as well as potential for future growth of Bihar's economy

Research Activities

The college is actively involved in research and consultancy. To update with contemporary issues, a vibrant and vigilant Research Cell comprising of senior faculty members pertaining to different knowledge dimensions are continuously working to observe, analyze and conclude with consequences of various socio-economic issues.

The recent achievement of the Research Team is the successful publication of the study on the topic 'An Impact Assessment Study of the Solar Charkha Project being successfully implemented in the Nawada district of Bihar.' The report was submitted to the Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises, Govt. of India. The Research Team also carried out 'An Impact Study Of The Prime Minister Ujjwala scheme' and submitted the report to the Ministry of Petroleum and Natural Gas, Govt. of India. The College has also conducted 'A Diagnostic Study of English Language Proficiency in Government Engineering Colleges & Polytechnics in Bihar, report was submitted to Department of Science and Technology, Govt. of Bihar.' As a part of economic concern towards the society the Research Team of the College has also carried out "An Analytical Study of MUDRA Yojana in Bihar." In furtherance to these studies the college has taken up "Bihar Right to Public Grievance Redressal Act, 2015: An Impact Assessment Study in Bihar." These studies were self-financed.

On the occasion of Founder's Day – 24th June, 2020 (Celebration of birth anniversary of its founder Chairman – Hon'ble Dr. Jagannath Mishra Ji) the Research Committee released two reports related to CORONAVIRUS (COVID19) titled- 1. कोविड - 19: आपदा एवं अवसर (आत्मनिर्भर भारत निर्माण में केन्द्र सरकार की योजनाएँ) – The report covers Central government's response to the COVID-19 pandemic. When in January 17, 2020, the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare acknowledged the emergence of a new (COVID-19) that was spreading across China. As the spread increased and more information about the virus was uncovered, the central government announced several policy decisions to contain it. Further, measures were also announced to support citizens and businesses who were affected by such containment measures. The Finance Minister announced a relief package of 1.7 lakh crore rupees under the Pradhan Mantri Garib Kalyan Yojana for the poor. A lockdown came into force to control spread of COVID-19 laid all establishment other than essential goods and services, and those involved in agricultural operations. All state/UT governments have been directed to arrange for shelter and food for the needy, including migrant workers and quarantine facilities for at least 14 days. In continuation to massive support and welfare schemes for common citizen, Hon'ble Prime minister announced Garib Kalyan Rojgar Abhiyan to assure employment of migrant workers at their native place.

2. कोरोना काल में बिहार में रोजगार सृजन : चुनौती या अवसर – The concern of Hon'ble Chief Minister Sri Nitish Kumar towards employment is kept as theme. The college research team has pulled their shocks to unveil the opportunity for economic sustainability of state economy during and Post-covid period. The report highlights potential avenues and also suggest on restructuring of low yielding sectors. Another notable feature of the report is that it focus beyond "Jal-Jivan-Hariyali Abhiyan." The team took necessary steps and analysed to identify the under exploited resources and sector in which mass employment is possible even in rural areas to resume work for migrant workers as well as existing unemployed.



Faculty Development Programme



The College encourages in-house and outside campus group workshops and individual consultations for the faculty to develop and explore creative pedagogic methods. The latest hosting in this connection was based on the theme of "classroom management and creating interest among students towards learning." Mrs. Smitha Purohit, an eminent counsellor-cum-trainer widely explained the technique and shared tips to use resources for different settings and outcomes.

The faculty members are encouraged to participate in different Seminars/ Webinars/Conferences and workshops organised at various institutions and Universities of the country. The aim of the faculty development programmes is to promote campus-wide excellence in teaching which supports the nurturing of new students and foster professional development of students.

Academic Support During Lockdown

The College has been very much curious about its students. During 'Lockdown' in the corona pandemic situation in the country, the classes of the Universities and colleges were announced to be suspended till further notification. To keep on continuing study habits of students and to maintain the syllabus, the college feels pride to be first in the University to start on-line classes of students immediately after the announcement of class suspension. This also helped students come out of boredom mental state of Lockdown. The faculty members of the college have been consistently conducting online classes during Lockdown period using different digital platforms. In addition to e-contents as ppt, pdf, audio, question-answer sessions, online tests, etc. to provide seamless learning to our students. They have been also attending their own self development programmes online viz. webinars, short-term advanced courses for the sake of benefits to the students. The college also organised online classes from the College by hiring a third party for conducting and recording the online classes, so that the recorded classes be remain available off-line for our students.



Student Development Programmes

Events & activities are organized by the college for students which provide them an opportunity to learn ideation, planning & execution. It has direct impact on team building & resource management, sense of urgency etc. Such traits also help them develop life skills. The two recent interactions in this regard were with Mrs. Smitha Purohit, an eminent counsellor-cum-trainer and motivator who interacted students for different spheres of goals. She educated and trained students through creative learning, knowledge games, role playing and Personality development.

Career Counselling
